What is Registered Apprenticeship?

Registered apprenticeship is a formalized training program combining on-the-job training and related technical instruction in which paid employees receive practical and technical training in a highly skilled occupation.

Apprenticeship programs usually last between 1 and 6 years. During that time, apprentices work and learn under the direction of experienced journey-workers. Over time, apprentices are provided the diversity and complexity of training that leads to becoming highly skilled in their occupations.

As the apprentices gain skill, they are compensated through an increase in wages.
